Road Construction Markey Pkwy

The City of Belton has begun work on the new Markey Parkway extension project. A detour will be in place for the next week or so (including possibly 2 Sundays if delayed due to weather, otherwise 1 Sunday) that not allow entrance from 163rd/Y Hwy. The existing church entrance will be open during this time, but you will need to access it via Locust Hill Road and QT Way. Note: There are barriers on QT Way and road closed signs, but you are able to drive around the barriers on QT Way to reach the church entrance.
