Hey CrossRoads Family!

I want to share some pieces from one of my absolute favorite prayers with you from my favorite meditative book called, "A Rhythm of Prayer: A Collection of Meditations for Renewal." This is called, "A Prayer Against Efficiency" and is written by Micha Boyett.

Oh God beyond time, beyond the number line, the hourglass. Beyond moons that wax and wane and waves that push and pull along our fragile ground. Oh God beyond days and weeks and months, God uncontained by our twenty-hour hours, free of our borders and yet still within them.

God who is here. God of the meetings, the emails, the PTA, the neck ache, the child crying over homework, the car leaking oil, the head lice, and the sheets to wash...

God beyond time, we come to you pulled by the bullet points in our calendars, by the titles we keep beside our names, by the goals we've charted and the accomplishments we list to define our value...You, God, touch our distortions and soothe the edges of our efficiency, and only you can make us real.

God beyond the boxes we build to contain our lives, the hours we track and tally. God outside of time, yet here: Come to us, relieve our ragged breaths, slow our steps, relax the red lines that spike in our brains. Tell us what is true. Show us how time rolls like calm water, let us cup it quiet in our hands.

God, teach us to pause in this moment, to tuck ourselves in the curve of your slow arm, that we may know the miracle of now, the gift of this moment: you beside and beyond us, welcome us outside of all we measure, and standing with us in it. May we see the goodness of our still hours and days, sunrises, sunsets, and the darkness where our rest is found.

Order us, that we may stand within time holding your hand. That we may know we are enough, not because of what we make of these hours, but because within these hours – with you- we are being made.

May you chew on these morsels of truth that push us beyond our daily grind.

Belton BackSnack Grows to Pirate Pantry

About twelve years ago Carl Gum heard a presentation from the Belton Education Foundation at a Rotary meeting. Our Mission Chair met with the BEF Director and learned that many of our Belton school children suffer from serious food shortages which impair their ability to concentrate and learn. So CrossRoads joined the other organizations in town that support the BackSnack program.

Early on, a group of us met at the District Office and actually packed the food into the backpacks. Then we took the backpacks to the schools. Now the food comes pre-packed by Harvesters and the District delivers it to each school.

The Belton Education Foundation has expanded the services provided and therefore changed the name to Pirate Pantry. Elementary kids still get the backpacks of food to carry them through the weekend. But now all schools have pantry areas where kids who didn't get breakfast at home can grab a nutrition bar or shake to carry them to lunch. The pantries are also stocked with socks, underwear, and sweat pants for children who might have an accident that would interfere with their ability to concentrate and learn.

For several years we met the \$7000 goal we had set for each school year. Last year we donated \$5500. Right now, we have collected \$1027 and the school year is almost half over. We need to shake a leg, folks! Please see if there is any way that you can contribute to this important ministry to the children of our community. And thanks so much for all the good each of you are doing!



2024 Advent Study

Our 2024 Advent 4-week book study will begin on Nov. 25th and 26th. You may choose from Pastor Erika's Monday evening 6:00pm virtual zoom session (Nov 25, Dec 2, 9, 16), Pam Ekey's Tuesday morning 10:00am session in room #105 (Nov 26, Dec 3, 10, 17), or Randy Kelly's Tuesday evening 6:00pm session in room #105 (Nov 26, Dec 3, 10, 17).

You will read Walter Brueggemann's "Names for the Messiah". In Isaiah 9:6, a divine utterance is given to us using four royal titles Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. "Names for the Messiah" ponders each title and how the people understood it then, how Jesus did or did not fulfill the title, and how Christians interpret Jesus as representative of that title. Christians have claimed from the beginning that Jesus was the Messiah foretold in the Old Testament. The author tackles the questions: "What were these expectations? and Did Jesus fulfill them?"

We have ordered the books (used from Thriftbooks) for all who wish to participate, and the price is \$6.00 each. So that we will have enough on hand, we'd like you to sign up as soon as possible. There will be a clipboard out Sunday or you can sign up right now. If we run out of books, we will order additional copies from Amazon at \$9.00 each.
